

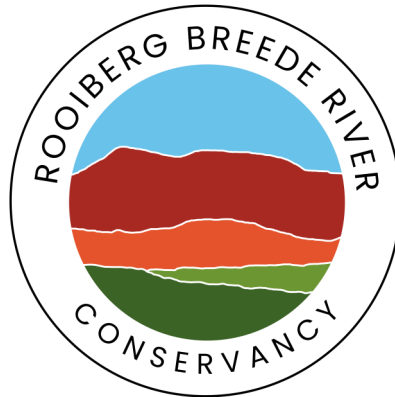

- The Rooiberg Breede River Conservancy was established as a non-profit organisation in 2013.
- The Conservancy spans the region from the Nuy Valley to the Willem Nels River from west to east, and the Langeberg Mountains and the Breede River from north to south.
- We have an in house nursery that cultivates indigenous, water wise plants.
- Rooiberg Winery's Game Reserve wine range celebrates the unique indigenous animal and plant species within our area. For each bottle sold, a contribution of R3 is made towards Karoo Conservation.

Rooiberg Breede River Conservancy has been active since 2006, and since 2013 has been registered as a non-profit company. With project funding from the Leslie Hill Succulent Karoo Trust facilitated by WWF South Africa, and with the generous support of donors and corporate sponsors, the conservancy has employed its own full-time manager since 2020. In this way, the Conservancy has grown from a small, informal initiative among a handful of environmentally conscious landowners, to a well-developed institution in its own right able

to assist members with environmental management and sustainable agriculture needs such as alien invasive plant clearing, soil erosion control, rehabilitation planting, environmental threat management, and education about the region's wealth of flora and fauna. As a landowner or manager, you are the custodian of your land. You know its wildlife and its plants, and you also know the environmental challenges it faces.
